<div>erecting, completing, remodeling, or equipping or reequipping school buildings or other facilities, or parts of or additions to those facilities; furnishing or refurnishing school buildings; acquiring, preparing, developing, improving, or equipping structures, athletic fields, playgrounds or sites, or parts of or additions to sites, for school buildings or other facilities; and acquiring, installing, or equipping or reequipping school buildings for instructional technology?</div>
<div>The following is for informational purposes only:</div>
<div>The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2021, under current law, is 1.18 mills (\$1.18 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a 0.00 mill net increase over the prior year’s levy of 7.00 mills. The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is thirty (30) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 4.04 mills (\$4.04 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).</div>
<div>The school district expects to borrow from the State School Bond Qualification and Loan Program to pay debt service on these bonds. The estimated total principal amount of that borrowing is \$6,499,371 and the estimated total interest to be paid thereon is \$6,824,042. The estimated duration of the millage levy associated with that borrowing is 18 years and the estimated computed millage rate for such levy is 7.00 mills. The estimated computed millage rate may change based on changes in certain circumstances.</div>
<div>The total amount of qualified bonds currently outstanding is \$32,140,000. The total amount of qualified loans currently outstanding is approximately \$1,601,284.</div>
