**MILLAGE PROPOSAL**  
**BUILDING AND SITE SINKING FUND TAX LEVY**

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Kent City Community Schools, Kent, Ottawa, Muskegon and Newaygo Counties, Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed 1 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2004 to 2008, inclusive, to continue to provide for a sinking fund for the purchase of real estate for sites for, and the construction or repair of, school buildings and all other purposes authorized by law; if approved, the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect the first year of levy, 2004, is approximately \$150,304 (.9648 mill of the above is a renewal of millage for sinking fund purposes which expired with the 2003 tax levy and .0352 mill is to restore millage lost as a result of the "Headlee" reduction)?
